The Right Care



Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) is a health monitoring and activities program that's designed to promote independence—and delay institutionalization—of disabled adults.

This program provides a supportive and friendly atmosphere for adults age 18 or older that require ongoing rehabilitation and medical services.

Open Monday through Friday, St. Luke ADHC offers a variety of attendance options. Registrants can attend up to five days per week, or as few as one day per week.

Registrants are offered a variety of services that are tailored to fit each adult's specific needs.

Personal care services range from health and medical care to:

- Case management
- Health assessment
- Physical rehabilitation therapy
- Speech therapy



- Dental services
- Therapeutic diets
- Nutritional education, and more!
